PUNISHMENT FOR MALPRACTICE

S.No.	Nature of Malpractice	Maximum Punishment
1.	Appeal by the candidate in the answer script to show mercy by way of awarding more than deserving marks.	I - Fine of Rs.2000/- per Course.
2.	The candidate writing his/her name in the answer script.	
3.	The candidate writing his/her registration number /college name in place other than specified in the answer script.	
4.	Any special marking in the answer script by the candidate.	
5.	The candidate communicating with neighboring candidate orally or non-verbally: the candidate causing suspicious movement of his/her body.	I - Fine of Rs.2000/- per Course.
6.	Irrelevant writing by the candidate in the answer script.	
7.	The candidate writing answer on his/her question paper or making use of his/her question paper for rough work.	
8.	The candidate possessing of cell phone / programmable calculator(s)/any other electronic storage device(s) gadgets.	II - Invalidating the examination of the particular Course written by the candidate.
9.	The candidate facilitating the other candidate(s) to copy from his/her answers script.	
10.	The student possesses any incriminating material, whether used or not: written or printed, photo copied, bits of papers containing written information, writings on scale, calculator, handkerchief, dress, part of the body, hall ticket etc.	
11.	Student destroys any evidence pertaining to a malpractice	
12.	The candidate possessing any incriminating material(s) (whether used or not). For example: - Written or printed materials, bits of papers containing written information, writings on scale, calculator, handkerchief, dress, part of the body, Hall ticket, etc.	III A - If the quantum of the incriminating material is less than that could normally be printed in two lines of A5 size paper, then punishment is restricted to the Course concerned only.
13.	The candidate possessing cell phone(s)/ programmable calculator(s)/any other electronic storage device(s) gadgets and containing incriminating materials (whether used or not)	

14.	The candidate possessing the question paper of another candidate with additional writing on it.	<p>normally be printed in the full page of the A5 size paper, then the punishment is invalidating the examination of the Course concerned and further the candidate is not considered for any moderation and reevaluation in the current semester for any Course (including arrear Course).</p> <p>III C - When the quantum is equal to or more than that could normally be printed in full page of A5 size paper, then the punishment would be invalidating the examinations of the Course concern and all the theory and the practical Courses of the current semester registered by the candidate. Further the candidate is not considered for reevaluation of answer scripts of the arrear Courses.</p> <p>If the candidate has registered for the arrear Courses only, invalidating the examinations of all the arrear Courses registered by the candidate.</p> <p>The punishment does not include Project work and the Courses with 100% internal evaluation.</p>
15.	The candidate passing his/her question paper to another candidate with additional writing on it.	
16.	The candidate passing incriminating materials brought into the examination hall in any medium (hard / soft) to other candidate(s)	
17.	The candidate copying from neighboring candidate.	
18.	The candidate taking out of the examination hall answer booklet(s), used or unused.	
19.	Appeal by the candidate in the answer script coupled with a promise of any form of consideration.	
20.	If any malpractice is detected which is not covered in the above clauses 1 to 17 that shall be reported to the Chief Superintendent and COE for the further action.	

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
