The Red Ribbon Club of SVHEC organized an awareness seminar on blood safety on February 21, 2025 (Friday) at the college auditorium. The chief guest, Mr. P. Duraisamy, District Executive Manager of the Erode District AIDS Prevention and Control Unit (DAPCU), provided an in-depth explanation to the students about the four types of sexually transmitted diseases that can result from improper blood safety and the preventive measures they can take. During his speech, he also highlighted the importance of personal hygiene, the physiological and mental health issues linked to drug use, and the impact of child marriage, supported by data from field studies.

Another guest speaker, Mr. S. Sridhar, Consultant at the Integrated Counseling Center of Siruvalur Government Primary Health Center, gave a comprehensive overview of the AIDS and STD Treatment Center at government health centers and the treatment services they offer. The event was organized by the members of the college's Red Ribbon Club, with approximately 300 heads of departments, professors, and students in attendance. The seminar was inaugurated by Prof. V. Saraladevi, Head of the Department of English, who delivered the welcome address. The event concluded with a vote of thanks from the RRC Coordinator, Mr. B. Vigneswaran.
